## FOR

Professionals in the field of performing arts: music, dance, mime, theatre, installation and crossover art.

#### **FOCUS**

- A. Integrating music, performing body and light into the spatial composition.
- B. Musicality of Movement as the approach for improvisation towards composition.

#### **SUBJECTS**

- A. Mime/ Physical Acting
- The 'ABC' for stage performance. Including articulation technique, partner work, dramaturgy of the body and space, neutrality, transformation, relation body objects space.
- B. Musicality of Movement
- Technique: separate and inclusive exploration and practice of musicality in the different aspects: body & action/ space/ time/ sound/ music instrument & objects / Improvisation
- Composition from a theatrical point of view: Creating poetry in abstraction by exploring different choices; visible - audible - sensible; inside/ outside location.
- Real Time Composition: instantly integrate all physical and stage aspects into creation.
- C. Working with Theatre Light, from electricity to dialogue.
- Technique: the physics of lighting based on theory and practice.
- Composition / Design: the architecture of light/ interaction between performer, objects, light, and space.
- D. Stage Management (including safety and security, adapting to different locations)
